

Students Bill of Rights

- 1. The right to meet with other religious students.** The Equal Access Act allows students the freedom to meet on campus for the purpose of discussing religious issues.
- 2. The right to identify your religious beliefs through signs and symbols.** Students are free to express their beliefs through signs and symbols. (Including Christian t-shirts, etc.)
- 3. The right to talk about your religious beliefs on campus.** Freedom of speech is a fundamental right mandated in the Constitution and does not exclude the school yard.
- 4. The right to distribute religious literature on campus.** Distributing literature on campus may not be restricted simply because it is religious.
- 5. The right to pray on campus.** Students may pray alone or with others so long as it does not disrupt school activities or is not forced on others.
- 6. The right to carry or study your Bible on campus.** The Supreme Court has said that only state directed Bible reading is unconstitutional.
- 7. The right to do research papers, speeches, and creative projects with religious themes.** The First Amendment does not forbid all mention of religion in public schools.
- 8. The right to be exempt.** Students may be exempt from activities and class content that contradict their religious beliefs.
- 9. The right to celebrate or study religious holidays on campus.** Music, art, literature, and drama that have religious themes are permitted as part of the curriculum for school activities if presented in an objective manner as a traditional part of the cultural and religious heritage of the particular holiday.
- 10. The right to meet with school officials.** The First Amendment to the Constitution forbids Congress to make any law that would restrict the right of the people to petition the Government (school officials).

The Mission: The One Hour National prayer alliance purposes to stir up an atmosphere of prayer in the Body of Christ. And this is the call set forth; to continue in prayer as the guardians of this age and the age to come.

Supporting events vary from midnight prayer watches and to hosting one hour long prayer sessions in various locations, as the Holy Spirit leads.

**DEAR TEAM LEADER,
THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR DECIDING TO LEAD A "ONE HOUR" PRAYER TEAM ON YOUR LOCAL HIGH SCHOOL OR COLLEGE CAMPUS. AS A ONE HOUR TEAM LEADER WE ASK THAT YOU FOLLOW A FEW SIMPLE SUGGESTIONS THAT WILL HELP THE ONE HOUR CAMPUS PRAYER WATCH BE MORE EFFECTIVE.**

First, let's talk about pre-event steps.

Take flyers to your local FCA in schools. Ask them if you can post a flyer and share about the event.

If there are any other student Bible studies and/or religious organizations (Young Life, Campus Crusade, etc.) got to them and give them a flyer also. Ask if you can share about the event and get their people involved too.

Talk to other prayer groups/youth groups/churches and share with them the purpose of One Hour

and try to get them involved also.

Start praying now for the One Hour event, your group, and WNIM as we all prepare for this day.

Make sure your team knows where your meeting will be and when.

What happens during the One Hour event?

The focus of One Hour is to pray for one hour for America's college and high school campuses to experience revival.

Here are the 7 steps of prayer focus:

1. Start with repentance for God being taken out of America's schools.
2. Repent for the sins of our school systems (fornication, addictions, violence, idolatry)
3. Take authority over the spiritual atmosphere of our campuses.
4. Quote scripture about revival and victory. (Example: 2 Chronicles 7:14)
5. Ask God to heal the youth of our nation and campuses.
6. Ask God to pour out His Spirit in our land and on our schools.
7. Praise God and Thank God for the coming revival on the campuses of America.

Know that you can have different people in the group praying different parts as a whole or if you have many groups, you can separate them into smaller groups with individual leaders.

Make the hour of prayer intense and fervent prayer. Set the tone as the leader.

Get the names of people involved in order to strengthen the group for next year. If someone is interested in leading the group next year, have them call the office of Warrior Nations International Ministries.
